1. What is the probability that 4 letters chosen from 6 different letters will be chosen in alphabetical order?
2. You and two friends visit a pizza shop. There are 15 toppings. Six toppings are meat and the rest are vegetable. You each order a different topping (no repeats) at random. What is the probability that your group orders only meat toppings?
3. Four friends order a sweatshirt from a catalog. There are 14 colors of sweatshirts, 8 of which are all cotton and 6 of which are a blend. They each order a different color (no repeats) at random. What is the probability that the friends order only cotton sweatshirts?
4. A president and vice president are selected from a group of 5 girls and 4 boys. What is the probability that both the president and vice president will be girls?
